Background:

Kyambogo University, through its Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences, obtained a grant from the French Embassy -Uganda. Part of the grant caters for one Scholarship for M.A. French at the University of Artois, France. However, due to the global COVID -19 pandemic that has affected the normal conduct of business involving close contact, the studies will be conducted on Distance Learning mode at Alliance Française Offices in Kampala.

1. Objective:

The objective of the programme is to train Masters scholars who will support the Teaching and Learning of French in the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences at Kyambogo University.

2. Selection Criteria:

The following criteria is mandatory. Applicants should:

- a) Be citizens of Uganda
- b) Possess the required academic qualification for admission to the Programme. i.e Possess a First Class or Second Upper Class Bachelor's degree in Education (**French**) OR a Bachelor of Arts with Education (**Majoring in French**) obtained from a recognized University by December 2016.
- c) Have taught French at least for three (3) years
- d) Have a good command of the French language both oral and written
- e) Below 35 years of age
